Axe Thrower	Overenthusiastic participants	Responsible adult supervising at all times	2	1	1	Consider additional supervisees
Axe Thrower	Risk of injury	Ensure that no one with a history of back or neck problems or anyone who is feeling unwell or suffering the effects of alcohol or drugs & Pregnant women may NOT use the equipment at any time. Participants to play one at a time under supervision of a responsible adult. Axe's to be thrown into the target area only.	1	5	5	None
Axe Thrower	Inflatable tipping	Ensure there are no participants or spectators within the target area when inflatable is in use. Do not sit, lean or lie on the inflatable at any time.	1	3	3	None
Axe Thrower	Risk of injury to spectators	Participants must be aware of their own abilities and use the equipment with due care and common sense. Axe's are only to be thrown into the target area direction. Too much force may bounce the axe's out of the target area.	1	3	3	None
Axe Thrower	Adverse Weather	Item will be switched off in heavy rain and is not permitted to run in strong winds as both these conditions can be deemed a health and safety risk.	Weather dependent	Weather dependent	Weather dependent	Consult Adverse weather policy
Axe Thrower	Tripping on anchorage and electrical cables	Anchor points used as per manufacturers instructions and spare equipment erected safely or stowed away. Where possible electrical cable does not cross any public pathway.	1	1	1	Prevent participants from running around the inflatables
Axe Thrower	Injury from incorrect positioning	Do not move or try to reposition the inflatable under any circumstances and ensure that the anchors are in place at all times.	1	2	2	None
Axe Thrower	Risk of fire from generator	Blowers/generators are filled with fuel before delivery, units are fire retardant.	3	1	1	All spare fuel is stored in suitable marked container, and in a safe location, units switched off during re fuelling
Axe Thrower	Choking	No food drinks or chewing gum to be allowed on or near the Inflatable.	1	4	4	None
Axe Thrower	Injury from 3 rd party items	Spectacles and badges/broaches MUST be removed before using this Inflatable game.	1	5	5	None
Axe Thrower	Danger from fire	No smoking or barbeques near the inflatables at any time	1	5	5	None
Axe Thrower	Emergencies	In the event that someone is seriously injured, DO NOT move the individual, leave the inflatable switched on and dial 999 immediately.	2	3	5	None
